



## SPECIFICATIONS

### Contractor Requirements

The contractor is responsible for securing all permits for the program on an annual basis. On an annual basis the contractor shall provide all information necessary such as pesticide labels to the NYSDEC to secure the annual NYSDEC permits. Application to the NYSDEC shall be made by the contractor during January of each season. The contractor shall coordinate with the Commissioner of Parks and Recreation or designee in carrying out the program. The contractor shall coordinate with the Department of Environmental Control in connection with permitting for the program.

The contractor shall report findings and as needed coordinate and share information with the Suffolk County Vector Control and NYSDEC. The Contractor is responsible for all notifications that may be required by the NYSDEC in carrying out the program. The contractor shall comply with the NYSDEC permit and all applicable Federal, State and local laws in carrying out the program and complete all necessary recordkeeping. The contractor must be approved by the NYSDEC under the appropriate certification for aquatic and terrestrial application of the adulticides, larvicides, pupaecides and any other regulated chemicals utilized for the program.

#### 1. MOSQUITO CONTROL PROGRAM - CEDAR BEACH GOLF COURSE

The Town of Babylon Cedar Beach Golf Course experiences mosquito infestations on an annual basis that has the potential to close the facility during the golfing season. The intent of the program and requirement for the contractor is to reduce the mosquito populations to acceptable levels so that the golfers may utilize the facility during the golfing season.

The Cedar Beach Golf Course is located on the Town of Babylon Barrier Island on the south side of Ocean Parkway. See map. The contractor shall conduct a mosquito control program at the Town of Babylon Cedar Beach Golf Course from approximately May 1<sup>st</sup> to November 11<sup>th</sup> annually. As needed and or required by the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC), the contractor shall monitor adult and larval mosquito populations and mortality and the effectiveness of treatment as necessary. **The contractor shall respond to changing environmental conditions and apply treatments as needed and when requested by the Town of Babylon.**

#### 2. MOSQUITO CONTROL PROGRAM - 9/11 HOMETOWN MEMORIAL

The Town of Babylon 9/11 Hometown Memorial experiences mosquito infestations and the Town would like to reduce populations to acceptable levels for residents that visit the memorial.

The Hometown Memorial is just south of the Cedar Beach Golf Course. See map. The contractor shall conduct a mosquito control program at the Town of Babylon 9/11 Hometown Memorial

from approximately May 1<sup>st</sup> to November 11<sup>th</sup> annually. As needed and or required by the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC), the contractor shall monitor adult and larval mosquito populations and mortality and the effectiveness of treatment as necessary. The contractor shall respond to changing environmental conditions and apply treatments as needed **when requested by the Town of Babylon, office of General Services.**

The treatment for the 9/11 Hometown Memorial will be done at the **discretion** of the Town. Bidders should not assume that it will always be required while administering the program for Cedar Beach Golf Course. However, when requesting treatment for the 9/11 Hometown Memorial, the Town will schedule it in conjunction with the treatments at the golf course to minimize multiple trips. All requests must come from the Town of Babylon, office of General Services.

The Town of Babylon has specified a unit cost for this item because it is at the discretion of the Town, who will dictate the rate of application. However, the bidder must recognize that all requirements on page one are mandated for this item.

### **3. MOSQUITO CONTROL PROGRAM - AT TANNER PARK COPIAGUE**

Tanner Park is a Town of Babylon facility at Copiague that experiences mosquito infestations on an annual basis that frequently may impact summertime concerts. The intent of the program and requirement for the contractor is to reduce the mosquito populations to acceptable levels for concert attendees.

Tanner Park is located on the south shore of the Town of Babylon. See map. The contractor shall conduct a mosquito control program at Tanner Park from approximately May 1<sup>st</sup> to October 1<sup>st</sup>, annually. Concerts are held in Tanner Park twice weekly during the season.

Contractor will be expected to initiate treatments for all concerts. Concerts are twice weekly (Wednesdays & Fridays) and treatments must be applied in such a manner and timeframe as to prevent any ill effects for the patrons while still maintaining effective mosquito control during concerts. The Town will provide successful bidder with a schedule of concert dates and times.

As needed and or required by the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC), the contractor shall monitor adult and larval mosquito populations and mortality and the effectiveness of treatment as necessary. **The contractor shall respond to changing environmental conditions and apply treatments as specified above based on the concert series dates and schedule provided to them by the Town.**

The Town of Babylon has specified a unit cost for this item because concert dates will dictate the amount of applications. However, the bidder must recognize that all requirements on page one are mandated for this bid.

### **4. FLEA CONTROL PROGRAM - AT TANNER PARK COPIAGUE**

The Town of Babylon Tanner Park at Copiague has a feral cat population that the Town of Babylon and volunteers have been managing. A flea infestation has occurred at two locations within the park. The intent of the program and requirement for the contractor is to reduce the flea populations that are impacting the feral cats.

Tanner Park is located on the south shore of the Town of Babylon. See map. The contractor may conduct a flea control program at Tanner Park from approximately May 1<sup>st</sup> to November 11<sup>th</sup> annually. As needed and or required by the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC), the contractor shall monitor flea populations and mortality and the effectiveness of treatment as necessary. The contractor shall respond to changing environmental conditions and apply treatments **when requested by the Town of Babylon, Office of General Services.**

Successful bidder should not assume this item to always be utilized. The Town does not guarantee this program will be implemented. Usage of this item will be based on funding available and necessity, and is solely at the discretion of the Town of Babylon, Office of General Services.

The Town of Babylon has specified a unit cost for this item because it is at the discretion of the Town, who will dictate the rate of application. However, the bidder must recognize that all requirements on page one are mandated for this item.

**5. Emergency Calls (Mosquito Control Program only)** - Emergency applications are defined as being on Saturdays, Sundays or Holidays.

Bid pricing for emergency calls should be done as an additional fee per application unit cost. The additional fee would be **in addition** to the applications unit cost – based on which mosquito control program required the emergency visit.

All requests for any program administration must come from Town of Babylon, Office of General Services.

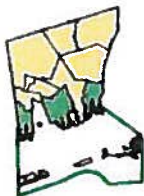

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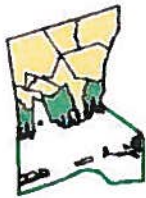


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**Tanner Park Mosquito Control Program**
